

Tracking Your Volunteer Hours



There are 2 ways to track the time you spend as a Maui County Health Volunteer.

1: Good old fashioned pencil (or pen) and paper. We have created a Volunteer Time Card to make it easy to keep track.

2: The www.PresidentialServiceAwards.gov website has a tool for tracking volunteer hours. You can log volunteer work done for any organization, not just Maui County Health Volunteers.

What is it? The President's Volunteer Service Award recognizes individuals, families, and groups who have achieved high levels of volunteerism (measured by the number of hours served over a 12-month period or cumulative hours earned over the course of a lifetime). We think it's a great idea for MCHV members to do this even if they do not plan to complete enough hours to earn an award. It's a way for you to track the valuable contributions you make to your community!

To get started, go to www.PresidentialServiceAwards.gov and click on "Track Your Hours." You will then see the screen below. Fill out the online form and click on "Create My Record of Service". On subsequent visits to the site, click on LOGIN and click on the "My Service" tab. When you get to the page entitled "My Volunteer Record," click on "Create New Record."
